

Tech Lancaster





Established in 2020 and supported by a group of companies led by Milliamp Technologies based in Storey House, it has grown from strength to strength and continues to deliver OFSTED regulated electronics and electech learning across England on behalf of the Department of Education's Skills for Life programmes. Tech Lancaster also helped to establish the regional trade body Electech Innovation Cluster which is now regularly seen running events around the White Cross Business Park and Fraser House. Electech companies supported by Tech Lancaster in the Morecambe Bay region over the past year have grown significantly (over 68%), with nearly 1000 people employed in 2024 generating over £161million of revenues. Tech Lancaster has played a key role in helping enable this growth and aims to continue to do so with its Skills Bootcamp programmes, and this has been recognised by visits from UK Government including representatives from 10 Downing Street witnessing our industry led learning and local electech companies.

The next Skills Bootcamp programme starts in September 2025 and is now enrolling new candidates. The free Skills Bootcamp helps participants aged 19 and over reskill and upskill into new, high value roles in electronics and electech industries. No previous experience or qualifications required - just a creative or technical aptitude and an enthusiastic attitude!

Hello to the White Cross community



Having recently moved into The Barracks,
I wanted to take the opportunity to introduce myself and
my business, Shift CBT and Coaching.

My name is *Kelly Robinson* and I am an accredited Cognitive Behavioural Therapist (often shortened to CBT) helping people who are experiencing stress, anxiety conditions and low mood. For the past 15 years, I have worked in the NHS and within Student Wellbeing at Lancaster University, and I have now set up a private CBT practice in the heart of Lancaster.

CBT is a form of psychological treatment that has been demonstrated to be effective for a range of problems. It is designed to empower people with tools and skills to start overcoming common mental health symptoms by creating helpful shifts in how a person thinks, feels and behaves. It is an evidence-based therapy, meaning it is backed by scientific research and studies demonstrating positive change.

Alongside CBT, I am also a certified Transformational Coach and I am currently working towards a further coaching qualification. Coaching is a collaborative conversation that can help people to achieve specific goals and unlock potential. It can help people take steps to get from where they are now, to where they want to be. I currently have limited availability for anybody that would like to explore coaching in exchange for a testimonial. Please do feel welcome to get in touch if you wish to explore free coaching opportunities.

I provide a confidential, non-judgemental and warm approach and my aim is to help people feel supported and comfortable. CBT is a collaborative style of therapy meaning that we work in partnership towards your goals. It can be hard to reach out for support and so I want people to feel very welcome.

I am able to provide sessions both online and in-person and offer a 15 minute no-obligation discussion for anybody who would like to find out more or explore options for support.



It was an immense privilege to be part of events to welcome King Charles on his historic visit to Lancaster Castle on Monday 9th June. Barbara, Founder of The Olive Branch and Linda, our Chair of Trustees were invited to join the Reception for Voluntary Organisations, as part of events to welcome the King on his visit to Lancaster Castle.

The Reception was a special opportunity to meet with representatives of other organisations, local dignitaries, MP Cat Smith, and even the King himself. As Linda described, "It was a memorable day of ceremony, music and conversation, culminating in several minutes with the King himself. He talked knowledgeably about tackling food poverty and was hugely encouraging of the work we do. It felt an honour to be there representing all those who support The Olive Branch week in and week out."

We are deeply grateful for the continued support of our community on White Cross Business Park. In May of this year alone, we gave out over 360 emergency food parcels to individuals and families in need, equivalent to over 13,000 items of food - which would not have been possible without the generosity of our community. In receiving such high numbers of guests, we have now used up most of the donations we were able to store from collections responding to our 2024 Harvest and Christmas Appeals. So, as we head into the summer and approach the school holidays, we would really appreciate your continued help to keep our shelves stocked so we can continue to support households facing hardship.
